Summary: The collection contains research notes anent Verstraelen's studies in Ghana (1965-1969) and Zambia (1972-1972), correspondence with African academic and clerical institutions, publications by Frans Verstraelen, research reports, conference reports, notes on African travels in journal form, newspaper clippings and magazines from miscellaneous African countries. The collection includes a photo-album of Gerdien Verstraelen-Gilhuis, as well as some of her correspondence and publications.

Acquisition: The archival material was donated to the Africa Study Centre by Frans J. Verstraelen in 2020, in addition to an extensive collection of books on the African continent from his personal library.

Biographical information¹:

Born in 1927 and growing up in the town of Steyl in the southern part of the Netherlands, which is home to the Society of the Divine Word (SVD), it is almost inevitable that Verstraelen

describes his involvement with the Catholic mission.² His first travels to Africa in 1965 were preceded by a number of educational courses, including philosophical and theological training with the SVD, at the Faculty of Missiology and followed the course Science of Religion at the *Pontificia Università Gregoriana* in Rome. He also attended the African and Social Studies at the University of Leuven and followed a course on Community Development at the Institute Lumen Vitae in Brussels and in Manchester. Verstraelen was able to broaden this theoretical framework throughout his life, as evidenced by the large collection of papers, journals and other publications present in the archive. In a practical sense, his prior experience included parish assistance, teaching courses in Latin, French and Music at the Minor Seminary-Gymnasium St. Willibrord in Deurne (two years), as well as the directorate of the educational centre ‘Kontakt der Kontinenten’ (Contact of the Continents) between 1961 and 1964.

As mentioned by Verstraelen himself, African realities were of course somewhat different, ‘more complicated and unforeseen’.³ The course at Lumen Vitae proved to be the most useful preparation for his future work in Ghana, as it included field-visits to various community development projects in Ghana in 1965. From 1965 until the end of 1969, Verstraelen acted as secretary of the Department of Lay Apostolate and Social Action of the National Catholic Secretariat (NCS) of the Catholic Bishop’s Conference in Ghana. Inspired by the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965), with its emphasis on inclusivity in the mission of the Catholic Church, Verstraelen laboured to involve the lay apostolate in the missionary task. This included organising retreat-sessions for secondary school pupils and organising lectures for Catholic organisations such as Young Christian Students and Pax Romana. Verstraelen’s position within the NCS allowed him to travel widely in West-Africa.

In Ghana (Lagon), Verstraelen continued to follow courses in African Studies, attending seminars on ‘Social Change in Africa’, ‘The Family in Africa’, and ‘African History’, the latter including a study on the travel-writings of Pieter de Marees. In 1969, at the end of his stay, Verstraelen was able to complete his MA-thesis on the impact of the Catholic Church on the socio-cultural life in (colonial) Ghana: *Catholic missionaries, Marriage, and Family Life in Ghana; A socio-historical study (1880-1960) with special reference to the coastal Akan*. An anthropological study on the relationships surrounding the compound of the landowner Wema

in the Yibanabia section of Nayaghenia near Navrongo remained unfinished. Verstraelen's experiences in these four years, embedded in the context of a rapidly changing Ghanaian society, are described in his Ghanaian diaries, which were published in Dutch in 2015.⁴

Following his work with the NCS, Verstraelen became the associate-director of the Department of Missiology of the Interuniversity Institute for Missiological and Ecumenical Research in Leiden, The Netherlands (1969-1989). The Institute's focus on research led him to undertake an exploratory journey (November 1970-January 1971) through seven countries in East- and Central-Africa, primarily in order to assess the possibilities for case-studies. As with Verstraelen's work in Ghana, the light of the Second Vatican Council shone through his efforts, as case-studies were to provide information on themes such as 'Religion and Development', and 'Mutual Assistance of missions'. These journeys helped him build a network among African research institutes, both the African and expatriate clergy, and lay personnel, on which he would fall back during his research in Zambia in 1973. This study, focussing on the localisation process of the Catholic Church in Zambia, is well-documented in Box 1 of the archive.

From 1976 until 1986, Verstraelen acted as General Secretary of the International Association for Mission Studies (IAMS). Three years later (1989), he became Professor of Religious Studies at the University of Zimbabwe, a role which he would fulfil until 1998. Throughout his career, Verstraelen wrote on missiology and the place of the Catholic Church in a changing Africa in numerous European and African magazines, newspapers and journals. Many of these publications are present in this collection.

Gerdien Verstraelen-Gilhuis:

Some of the sources present in the collection belong to Frans Verstraelen's first wife, Gerdien Verstraelen-Gilhuis.⁵ As a historian, she subscribed to a new way of approaching African Church history, which made use of African oral traditions and even fieldwork in contemporary communities. She accompanied Frans during the Zambia Project in 1973, for which she conducted a part of the archival research. It was during this first stay in Zambia that 'the seeds were sown' for her own historical research on African leadership in Zambian Church development.⁶ The photo-album which is present in the archive depicts scenes from her fieldwork in African communities in this period.

Description of the collection:

Please note: While repackaging the Verstraelen Collection for the removal of the ASCL it was noticed that some items described in the inventory are missing. These items are marked in red. Some of these items might have been included in the library collection.

VERS 1: Notebooks and Zambia Research

Most of the notebooks concern Frans Verstraelen's study of the localization process of the Catholic Church in Zambia, the place of foreign missionary assistance within it, and the scope for mutuality and exchange in its outside relationships. Special attention was paid to the 'promoting or hampering' role of expatriate missionaries in this localisation process.⁷ The box includes official documentation anent the set-up, progress and impact of the study, which took place in 1973; as well as correspondence with its supervisory committee and a range of involved individuals and institutions. During this project, the Dutchman's methodology seems to have been threefold. It included archival research, partly conducted by his wife Gerdien Verstraelen-Gilhuis, (semi-)structured interviews, and a questionnaire which he spread within the dioceses which he could not visit for interviews.

Verstraelen has added his Zambian notebooks. Among others things, these were used to document his interviews with the Zambian clergy, expatriate missionaries and the lay apostolate in the Diocese of Chipata (Serie 3) and the Archdiocese of Lusaka (Serie 2). The respective

parishes in Chipata and Lusaka are mentioned on the front page as well. *While topics could differ for each interviewee, the interviews roughly covered the following subjects:*

Biographical information interviewee – Zambianisation of the Church – Danger? – Few Zambian priests – More Zambian priests? – More expatriate priests? – Expatriate priests promoting – Laity – Expatriates leaving? – self-support – Educated Christians – Cath. Church foreign? – Leaders foreigners? – Older/younger mission – Selfhood – African Christianity? – Expatriates learning from African way? – African values – ZEC? (Zambia Episcopal Conference) – AZACC? (Association of Zambian Catholic Clergy) – Friendship – Modernization – Cath. Church other African countries – Role of Sisters – Sufficient information? – Other Catholic Churches? – Main problems?

Regarding the other series: Serie 1 (Gen.) contains general notes on topics such as Zambian parishes and clerical and lay institutions; Serie 4 (Varia) contains miscellaneous notes on the questionnaires, parishes and talks with Bishops. The non-serialized notebooks contain notes on travels in Ghana (1965), Tanzania and Zambia (1983), South Africa and Lesotho (1985), Zambia (preparatory visit, 1972), as well as copies of correspondence and reports.
