



Programme for the Roundtable

To prepare this volume and create and reinforce a network on labour issues, the ASC, in cooperation with HIVA, is hosting a roundtable discussion on **Wednesday 25 September** from 13:30 to 18:00. This meeting has been made possible by the generous support of the Leids Universitair Fonds (LUF), FNV Mondiaal and CNV Internationaal.

The aim is to bring together Dutch, African and other scholars with relevant expertise and also tradeunion practitioners to discuss current trends and the dynamics regarding labour issues and trade unions in Africa. To incorporate as many points of view as possible and increase the effectiveness of the discussion, three sessions each introducing a different 'entry point' will be held. Each session will have an introductory fifteen-minute pitch by an expert, after which the floor will be open for a plenary discussion.
